FILTROX PLANS TO EXPAND MANUFACTURING SITE IN UK

The Board of Directors of FILTROX has approved a major investment to expand the capacity of its manufacturing site in Barnoldswick (UK). The existing buildings will be enlarged and partly replaced with new ones. The expansion project is scheduled to be completed in 2024 and will increase the capacity of the site by more than 50%. It will create a world-class facility for depth filter media in full compliance with all quality standards of the food and pharmaceutical industries. This project supports the FILTROX Vision of being a global leader in depth filtration systems for valuable liquids.

The Board of Directors of FILTROX has approved a major expansion of its manufacturing site in Barnoldswick (UK). Over the next three years significant investments in buildings and production infrastructure will take place.

The investments include:

- Replacement of several older buildings with new, multi-storey buildings
- Addition of usable floor space by approximately 50%
- Increase of production capacity for flat depth filter media and lenticular modules by more than 50%
- Increase of converting, packaging and warehousing facilities
- New offices and laboratories

The investment will lead to a significantly improved utilization of the existing site at Butts Mill in Barnoldswick, which has been occupied by FILTROX Carlson Ltd. for many years. It will create approximately 40 new jobs.

The goal is to receive planning permission from the local authorities by the end of this year. Civil construction is scheduled for 2023 and the installation of the new production equipment and machinery in the following year. The aim is for the expansion to be fully operational by the end of 2024. The new factory will be in full compliance with all relevant quality standards of the food and pharmaceutical industries.

The manufacturing site in Barnoldswick is already the largest manufacturing site of FILTROX worldwide. It benefits from a strategic location in an area with a strong industrial background, good logistic connections with immediate proximity to seaports, and, most importantly, a highly skilled, motivated, and experienced workforce. The planned investment will further strengthen the position of the Barnoldswick site a as a world-class factory for depth filtration media. At the same time, the recently expanded manufacturing site in Tlalnepantla (Mexico) and our partner factory in Broumov (Czech Republic) will continue to be developed with significant investments to sustain the market growth of FILTROX. The FILTROX headquarter site in St. Gallen (Switzerland) will be gradually moving out of high volume industrial production and focus on research & development, engineering of filter equipment, marketing, application support, product management, and sales for the Central Europe region. This process will take several years and create a significant amount of free space at the current site in St. Gallen. FILTROX plans to develop this site together with a specialized partner. The existing buildings and the large land reserves will be transferred into a multi-use industrial park offering space for several hundred new jobs.


